



The Review

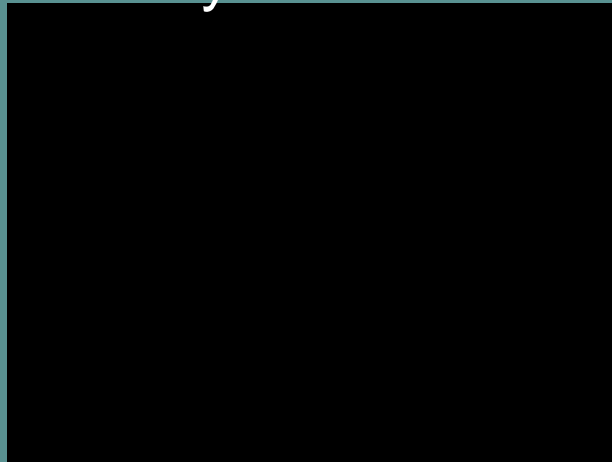
