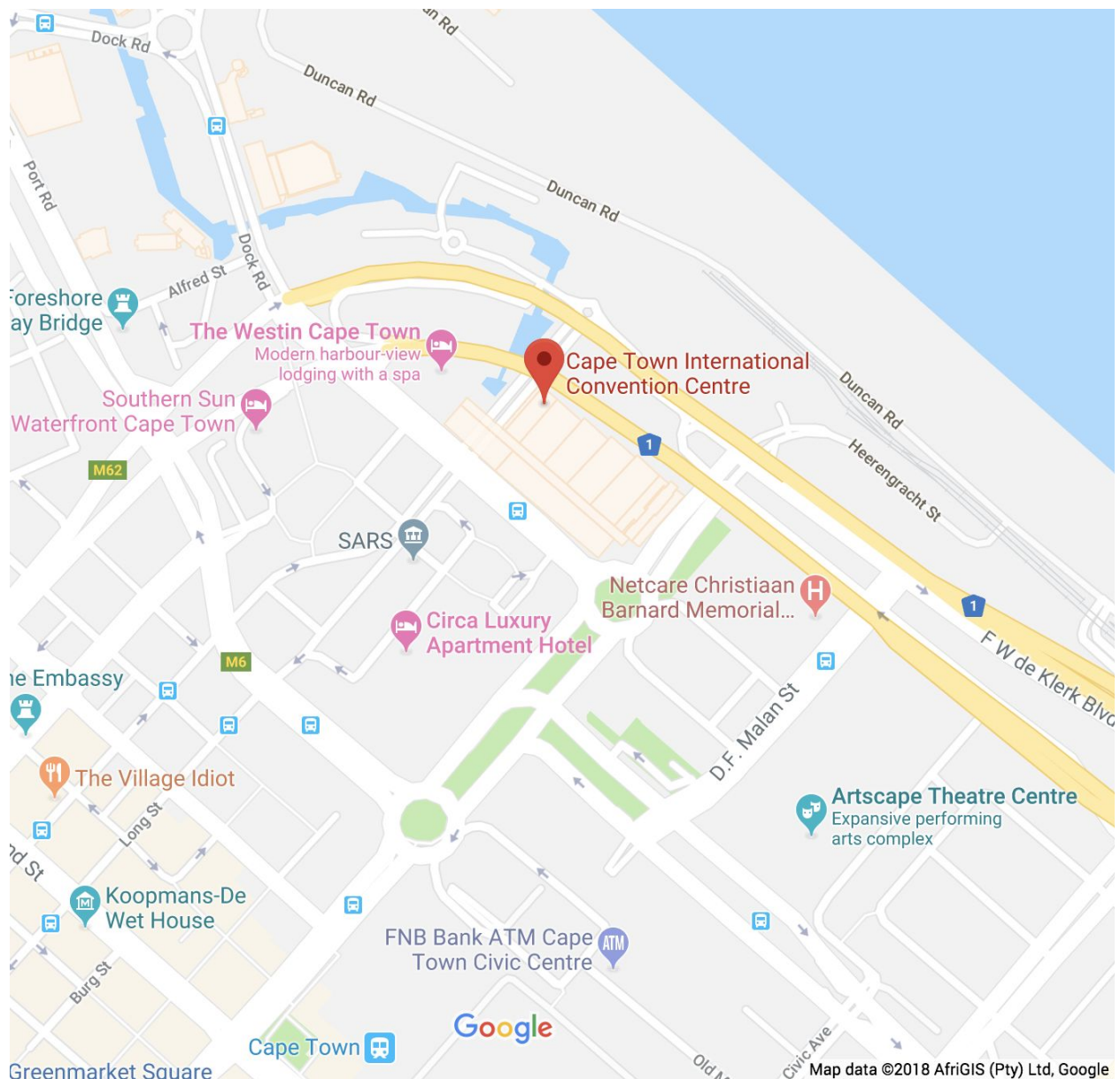

Venue information

MootAFR18 will be held across two levels at CTICC:

- Entrance is from Convention Square, 1 Lower Long Street, CTICC 1, Entrance 1, ground floor;
- Registration will take place in the Jasminium Conservatory, on Level 0.
- The Meeting Room 2.41 – 2.46, which is where we are holding our plenary sessions is located in Level 2
- The catering will be in the Jasminium Conservatory, on Level 0
- The exhibition area will be located on the Jasminium Conservatory, on Level 0
- Breakout rooms 2.61 – 2.63 and 2.64 – 2.66 are on Level 2. These can be accessed via stairs and elevators.

Getting there

There are many ways to get to CTICC, including catching taxis, underground, rail and buses.

- Integrated Rapid Transport System - Cape Town's sophisticated bus transport system.
- MyCiTi Shuttles - These shuttles offer efficient and safe public transport across the city. The CTICC is conveniently located on one of the MyCiti routes, which runs from the airport to the city.
- Taxi, Bus or Coach- Metered taxis, luxury air-conditioned coaches and shuttle buses regularly run between the airport, hotels, the city centre and most major tourist destinations.
- Train - Cape Town Central Station is situated in the heart of the city, while an extensive rail system connects the city centre with the rest of the region and the greater Western Cape.
- By Canal - The unique Roggebaai canal offers a relaxed, charming journey via water taxi between the Victoria & Alfred Waterfront and the CTICC.
- On Foot - The centralised and compact nature of the city means that walking is often the transport mode of choice for visitors.

Registration

The registration desk will be at the Jasminium Conservatory, on Level 0. Reception staff will direct you to our event and you can also follow the signs. You do not need a ticket or any printed proof to access the event - if you have registered correctly through Cvent you only have to say your name and last name at the Registration Desk and you will be given your badge (and your Moodle t-shirt!)

Day 1 of MoodleMoot Africa 2018
